

What to Bring with you on the Retreat

The Retreat Center features an extra large sewing room with plenty of space for everyone to sew together. You will have access to the sewing room any time day or night. You are welcome to stay up and sew till the wee hours of the morning, or take a break to enjoy the stars and catch a few winks before the sun comes up.

The following are just suggestions of what to bring with you on the retreat. Depending on your goals for the retreat you may pack differently. This list can help you not forget the most important things

- ⇒ Sewing Machine (well working order)
 - ⇒ Power cords and sewing feet (don't forget your 1/4" foot)
- ⇒ Simple or unfinished projects
- ⇒ Extra sewing machine needles
- ⇒ Scissors
- ⇒ Rotary cutter
- ⇒ Thread
- ⇒ Spare blades
- ⇒ Seam ripper
- ⇒ Your favorite pins
- ⇒ Cutting mat
- ⇒ Rulers
- ⇒ Marking pens and/or pencils for light & dark fabrics
- ⇒ Basic sewing supplies as required
- ⇒ Extra Fabric for incidentals
- ⇒ And don't forget your eye glasses if you wear them!

Optional Items

- * Baggies to store unfinished project pieces
- * A task light—table top lamp
- * Small personal craft iron & small ironing surface
- * Small spray bottle

Additional Information

- Ironing boards and irons as well as cutting tables will be provided at the retreat
- Don't forget to pack your personal toiletries as well as comfy clothes and shoes
